
Aim of the Partnership



- Concentrating research and innovation and the funding landscape of water in Europe and beyond.
- Enabling water security for all on the long term by boosting systemic transformations and changes across the entire water research and innovation pipeline, fostering the matchmaking between problem owners and solution providers.
 - cross-sectoral approach, encompassing policy, environmental, economic, technological and societal considerations.
- <u>continuum from knowledge development to the</u>




Main activities



A broad range of activities along the whole R&I chain of values, e.g.:

- Alignment of national and regional programmes; research synergies among networks;
- Joint calls, transfer calls, new formats to account for knowledge and innovation transfer;
- Joint activities beyond calls such as knowledge hubs, engaging with demonstration sites or living labs, roadshows, science-policy interface documents and events
- Contribution to UN monitoring, decrease of barriers in international cooperation.

Membership



- Member states in form of national/ regional funding institutions: Governing Board, decisionmaking body
- Associated Partners Board: all partners (industry, end-users) that formally do not belong to the partnership, but participate at certain activities, e.g.
 - In programming and coordinating its own activities in pillar A
 - Collaboration in areas of common interest (pillars C, D) through agreements

Timeline of decisions


- End May 2020: Official Publication of the Partnership candidate presentations by the EC
- July 2020: Commitments from partners requested by the EC
- 15 October 2020: Deadline for preliminary Member States commitments
- End of 2020: List of Partnerships finally retained for Horizon Europe Work Programme 2021 / 2022
 WP 2021 expected for Water4All
- At the time of adoption of the WP 2021/2: opening of calls for co-fund actions implementing co-funded partnerships.

Budget



The initial global budget estimation amounts to 400-450 Mio. Euro.

- depending of the number, range and type of demonstration sites / Living Labs willing to join
- EC Contribution: 50%
- Budget estimation, based on JPI activities ready







MS consultation on Water4All



- Consultation for Water4All launched end of June.
- Answers with quantitative commitments from 17 countries:
 - ► Cash for joint calls: 123 Mio. €
 - ► Cash for other pillars: 3 Mio. €
 - ► In-kind contributions: 70 M€
- Incomplete survey!
